Programming AutoCAD's programming model supports some unusual concepts such as that of Dynamic Commands and Dynamic Components. Percutaneous procedures generally involve the application of a trach tube to a patient's trachea by passing the tube through an incision or puncture in the patient's neck and down the patient's esophagus to the trachea. Percutaneous trach procedures can be associated with increased pain, discomfort, and risk of injury. In contrast, surgical trach procedures typically involve an incision in the patient's neck and the enlargement of a small incision to permit access to the trachea. The trachea is then split longitudinally and intubated, usually with a flexible tube, followed by the insertion of a trach tube through the flexible tube into the trachea. The flexible tube can be secured in place with sutures. The surgical opening can be closed by suturing the trachea, usually over a mechanical st
